## **COUNSELLING OF JELET-2011**

**(for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> Year of degree courses in Engineering/Technology/Pharmacy)  
INSTURCTIONS TO CANDIDATES**

*Instructions to JELET-2011 merit listed candidates (both diploma holders and B.Sc. candidates) who did not get any allotment through counselling to 2<sup>nd</sup> Year (3<sup>rd</sup> Semester level) of degree courses in Engineering/Technology/ Pharmacy (under Lateral Entry Scheme) but are willing to get themselves admitted to the Vacant seats of Engineering/Technology/Pharmacy in the 1<sup>st</sup> Year after JEM-2011 counselling)*

1. The venue of Counselling of JELET-2011 merit listed candidates is ***Yuba Bharati Krirangan (Salt Lake Stadium), Salt Lake, Kolkata-700098.***
2. Counselling Form [downloadable from website (a) [www.csc-et.in](http://www.csc-et.in) (b) [www.wbjeeb.in](http://www.wbjeeb.in) from 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2011] duly filled in should be brought at the time of counselling.
3. Counselling fee of Rs.500/- only (non-refundable) to be paid in the form of Bank Draft payable at Kolkata to be drawn in favour of “***Central Selection Committee (E&T)***” (The Bank Draft may be purchased from any Bank). The candidate should bring the said Bank Draft at the time of Counselling writing his name, enrolment no. and rank on the reverse side.  
***The candidates who have deposited the Bank Drafts during counselling of JELE-2011 for admission to 2<sup>nd</sup> Year (3<sup>rd</sup> Semester Level) of the degree courses in Engineering/Technology/ Pharmacy and have not taken any allotment, need not purchase the draft again. The Bank slips received from the Bank Counter at the time of deposit of Bank Draft will be accepted in place of Bank Drafts.***
4. **Eligibility criteria** – Diploma holders in Engineering/Technological/Pharmacy have to pass Diploma Examination from an AICTE approved Institution with at least 50% marks considering all semesters/parts in Diploma examination without any back paper(s) (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) and B. Sc. Degree holders have to pass B.Sc. Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC with at least 50% marks (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) and also have to pass XII standard with Mathematics as a subject. Diploma and B.Sc. Degree holders have to be merit listed in the JELET-2011 conducted by West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board.

5. **The students belonging to B. Sc. stream shall be considered only after offering the seats in this category to the students belonging to the Diploma Stream.**
6. A candidate called for counselling must report at the venue of counselling on the date and time as notified by the Central Selection Committee (Engineering & Technology) through websites.
7. A candidate failing to appear before the officials at the allotment counter in order of his/her position in the merit list due to delay on his/her part may be allowed to present himself/herself before the counselling officers immediately after the formalities in the reception counter are over.
8. The claim of such candidate (as specified in Sl. No. 7) to exercise option shall be limited to the vacancies prevalent at the instant when his/her turn comes for appearing before the counselling officials. An undertaking to this effect is to be given by the candidate at the time of counselling.
9. The option will have to be exercised in writing with his/her signature at the time of counselling. **Once the allotment of a seat is done, no further change of the Institution/branch will be entertained. No refund of money will be allowed under any circumstances.**
10. At the time of counselling candidates should report with the following documents.
  - i) Duly filled in counselling form
  - ii) Print out of the result indicating rank/overall rank from any of the websites as mentioned in Sl. No. 2
  - iii) Bank Draft of Rs.500/- (non-refundable)
  - iv) JELET-2011 Admit Card in Original
  - v) All **testimonials in original** for verification of eligibility and other criteria i.e. semester wise/part wise/year wise mark sheets of Diploma in Engg./Tech./Pharmacy or B.Sc. examination **in original** and for B.Sc. Degree holders Original mark sheet of H.S. or equivalent examination (XII standard) and also Original Admit Card/Certificate of Madhyamik (10<sup>th</sup> standard) or equivalent examination or Birth Certificate from competent authority for verification of age.
11. Candidates will be required to take admission to the allotted institution within 4 days from the date of allotment on payment of requisite fees to the respective Institution.

12. Besides the eligibility conditions prescribed by West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board, a few Institutions prescribe some more eligibility conditions specific to those Institutes. The candidates must note those specific conditions before giving options to those Institutions.
13. **Allotment by the Central Selection Committee (Engineering & Technology) is entirely provisional and subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria and other conditions specified in the Information Brochure of JELET-2011 at the time of admission. *All relevant norms and guidelines of D.G. Shipping are to be adhered to for admission to Marine Engineering Degree Course.***
14. Counselling in terms of schedule shall continue till availability of seats. The counselling of a particular Branch of Engineering/Technology will be stopped instantly as soon as all seats in that Branch of Engineering/Technology are filled up. No further queries in this regard will be entertained.
15. Any candidate appearing at the counselling with fake documents/testimonials will be handed over to the police instantly.
16. Any other important information related to the aforesaid counselling (if any) will be immediately communicated through the websites mentioned in Sl. No. 2.
